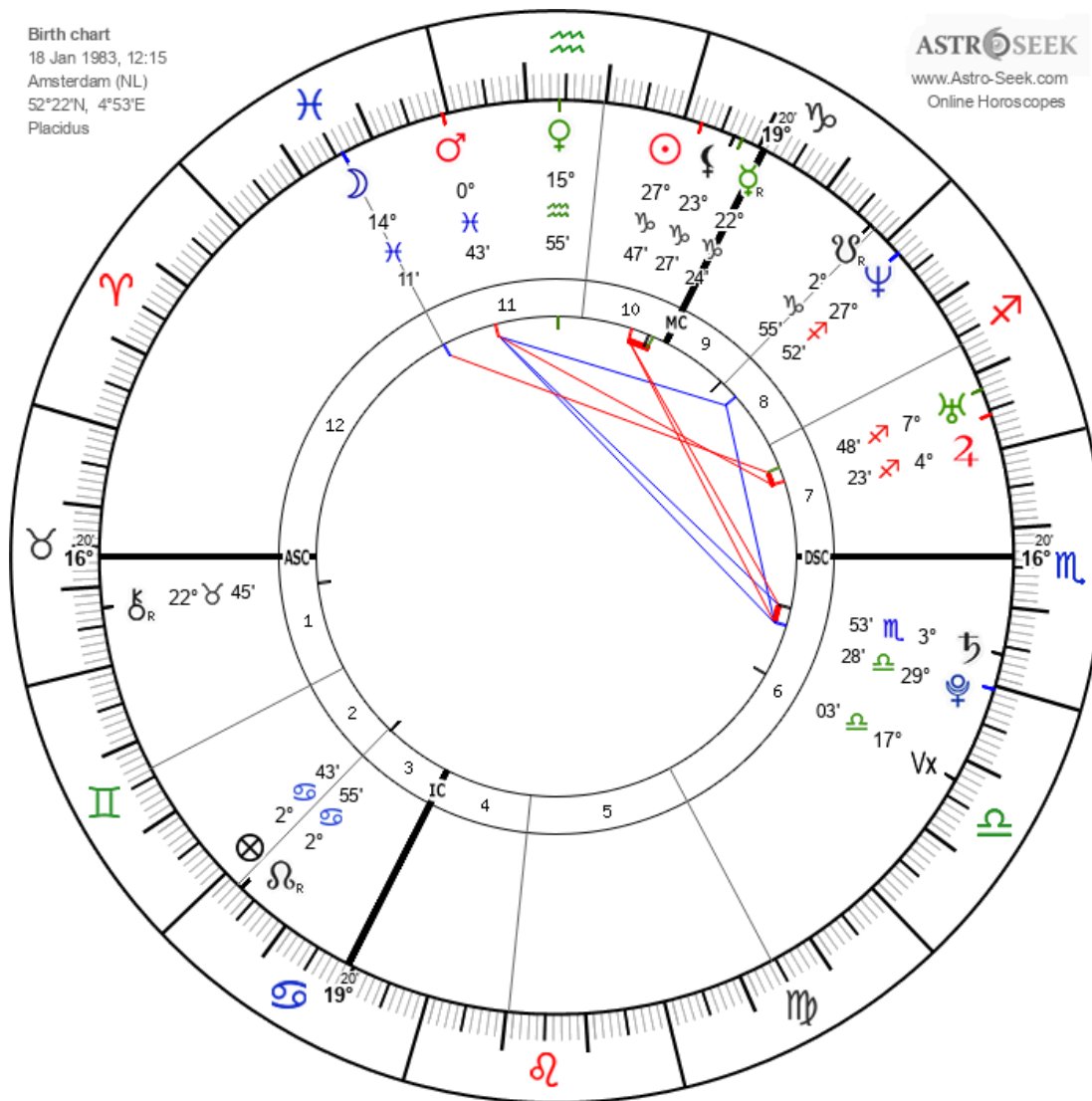
Ruling Planet: Saturn
